

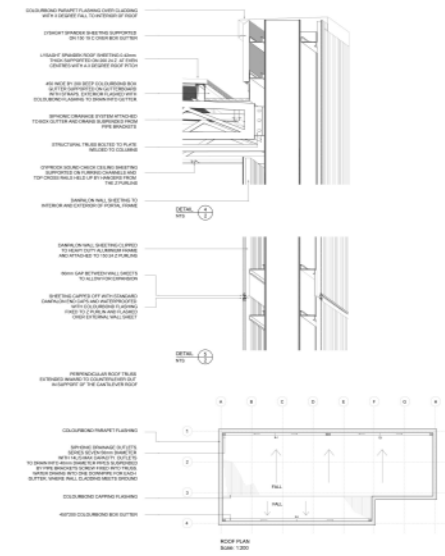
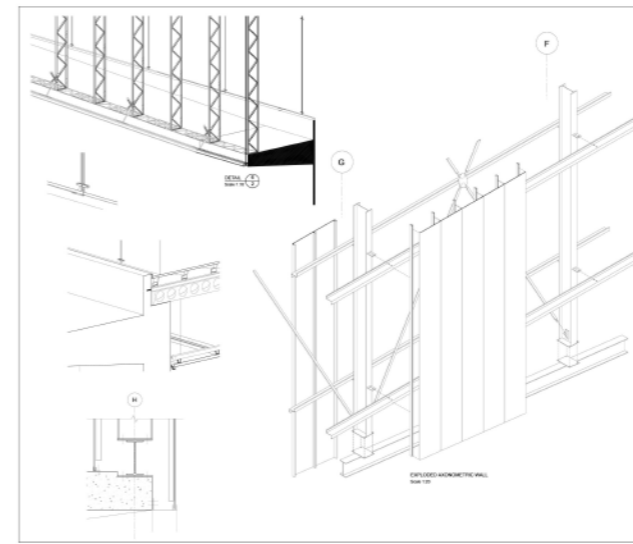
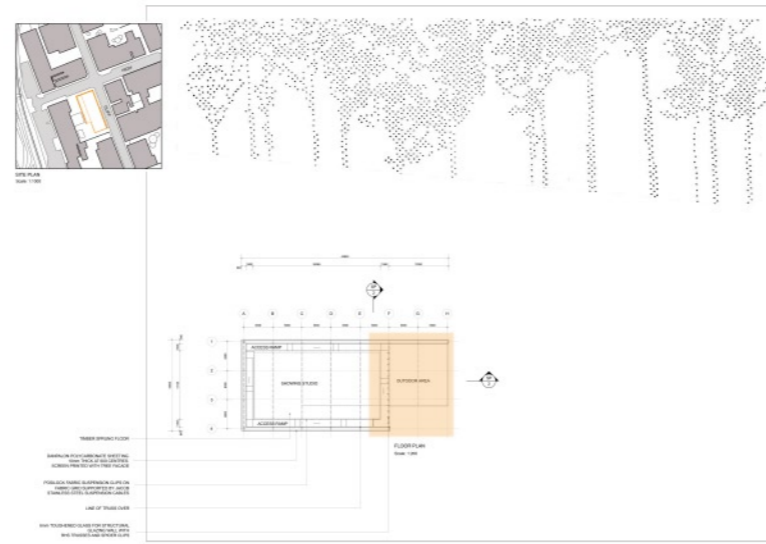

Maximum Groove Workshop Project 'Skinned Space'

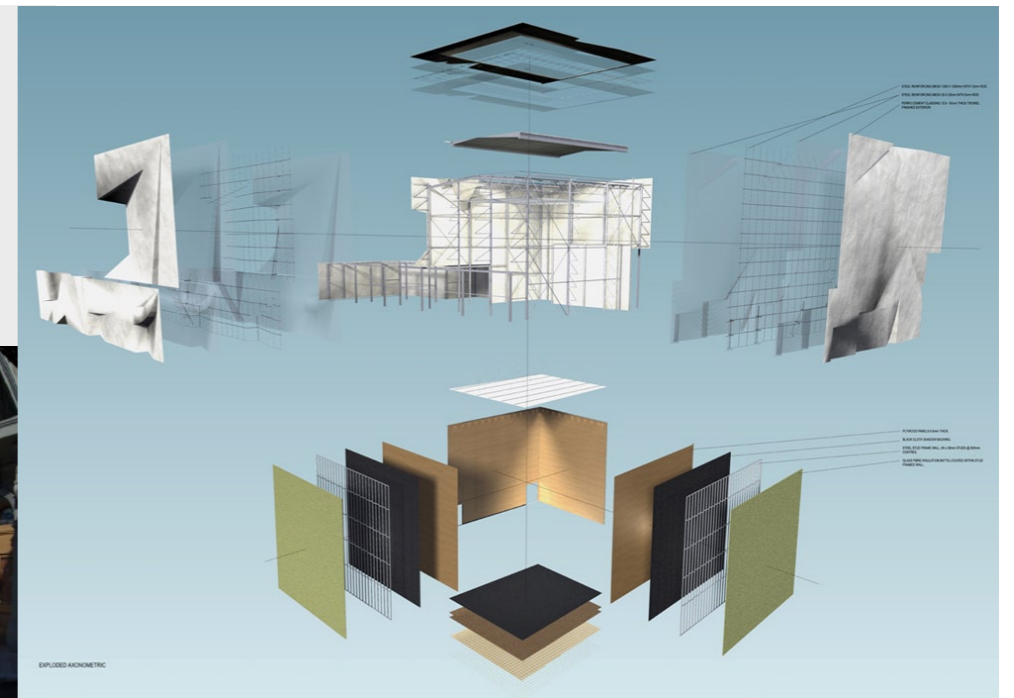
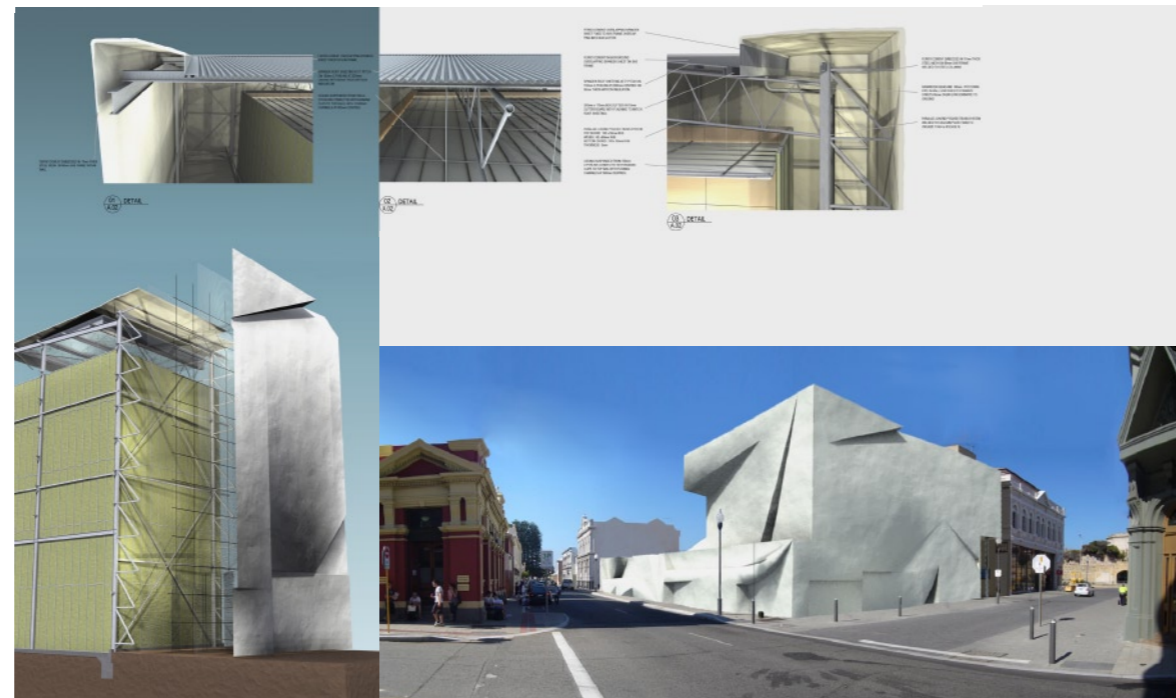
