Bus or Train

The Campus Bus Station is a 30-minute bus ride from the city with seven different routes servicing it. To find the fastest route from your accommodation, you can use the Transperth Journey Planner at <https://www.transperth.wa.gov.au/Journey-Planner>, or Google Maps which is a lot easier to use.

The Curtin Bus Station is 5 minutes' walk from building 402 and campus maps are provided on site and online at <http://properties.curtin.edu.au/maps/>

Car

The Bentley campus is about 15 minutes by car from the Perth city centre, which can increase to approximately 25 minutes during peak hour.

You can park in the yellow or green zone and will pay a maximum of \$6.00 per day. The nearest car parks for Building 402 are B11 and B12 off Beazley Ave or B5 off Brand Ave.

There are two ways to pay for parking on campus:

Conference Venues

State Library of Western Australia, Perth

The State Library is located in the Perth Cultural Centre which is bounded by the Perth Train Station, the Art Gallery of Western Australia and the Perth Institute for Contemporary Art (PICA).

The opening keynote and Q&A with Professor Kim Scott will be held at the State Library in the Theatre.

Curtin University, Bentley campus

Conference sessions will be held at Curtin's Bentley campus in building 402, either in the Lecture Theatre (402.220) or in rooms on floor 3. The building is accessible and a lift is available. Foyer areas within 402 and outside areas are available for delegate use.

The Sundowner will be held in the Creative Quarter on campus. Volunteers will be on hand to direct you there.

The Trade Fair will be held at the Guild Courtyard, near building 402. Volunteers will be on hand to direct you there.

The Moon All Night Café, Northbridge

The Moon is located at 2/323 William Street, Northbridge, a short walk from the Perth Train Station and bus stations. It is licenced and has a reasonably priced and delicious menu.
